Policies and processes for the administration of dispute resolution

Dispute resolution is an important aspect of any youth soccer club. Edmonton Sting recognizes that disputes may arise among players, parents, coaches, and volunteers. To ensure that disputes are resolved in a fair and equitable manner, the following policies and processes will be used:

- Communication: The first step in resolving any dispute is open and clear communication.
 All parties involved in a dispute are encouraged to communicate their concerns to each other in a calm and respectful manner. This may involve a face-to-face meeting, phone call, or email exchange.
- 2. Mediation: If communication between the parties is unsuccessful in resolving the dispute, the next step is mediation.
