The Responsible Coaching Movement (RCM) helps sport organizations in Canada ensure the health, safety and well-being of all participants, both on and off the field of play. Responsible Coaching promotes a safe and positive sports environment for all. From the coaches interacting with participants, to the volunteers and staff, everyone has a role to play to help keep sport safe, smart and secure.

This movement has three pillars:

- The Rule of Two
- Ethics Training
- Background Screening

We commit to this movement by:

- Having a Club minimum coach training requirements
 - Rule of Two
 - Safe Sport Training
 - Coaching In Canada
 - NCCP Coach Initiating in Sports
 - Anti-racism in Coaching
- Completing Police Information Checks, including vulnerable sector search. Mandatory for coaches, team officials, volunteers and staff. We re-new these every 3years.
